BEFORE YOU READ...

- How do most germs get spread?

Make predictions: Ask your listeners

- The book is called ahh-choo! What do you think it's going to be about?
- The germ on the cover seems to be moving pretty fast. Where do you think he might go?

Think critically: Ask your listeners

— What could that cat do to keep the germ from flying away?

 Use your listeners' answers to help determine how much detail to include in your discussion.
